Definition: (Excused vs. Unexcused)

Excused

- 1. Medical Doctor's note + Phone Call (make-up)
- 2. Illness Phone Call / Email Notification (make-up)
- 3. Illness Present at Practice (no make-up)

Note: Must be in attendance at school 3 out of 5 periods (IMMS)

- 4. Death in family Phone Call (no make-up)
- 5. STAAR Related (no make-up)
- 6. Family Emergencies + Phone Call (make-up)

Unexcused

- 1. Absences due to Vacation/Thanksgiving/Christmas /Spring Break
- 2. Illness No contact
- 3. Absent from Practice

Football

<u>Excused</u> - Athlete will do the same conditioning that the team performed the day the athlete missed.

- Athlete must complete 10 100yd sprints.
- Athlete will not start the game that week.

<u>Unexcused</u> - Athlete will do the same conditioning that the team performed the day the athlete missed.

- Athlete must complete 20 100yd sprints.
- Athlete will not start the game that week.

Note: Any unexcused absence also gives the coach the authority to not allow your student/ athlete to play that week. Excessive unexcused absences will result in complete removal from the program.

ACADEMICS

Student athletes are expected to maintain a grade average of 70 or above in every class. Student athletes must plan their time wisely. Using athletics as an excuse to not do your homework or using your homework as an excuse to not practice is not acceptable. Tutoring is available from 3:20 PM to 4PM. Student athletes WILL use this time to help ensure they pass their classes.

INJURIES

All injuries need to be reported to the event coach. The coach will then contact our trainer (Frank Acevedo) if necessary. In the event of an injury the student athlete will undergo treatment prescribed by the trainer. The student athlete will still be required to dress out, attend practice and games and fulfill any athletic responsibilities. If a doctor's note is turned in, the trainer must have a doctor's release note before returning the student athlete to practice or play.

Castleberry Independent School District Athletic Code of Conduct

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Participation in athletics is an opportunity provided to students who demonstrate a commitment to the classroom. The decision to participate in athletics includes the responsibility of maintaining the high standard of values identified in the Athletic Code of Conduct. Misbehavior will not be tolerated. To be a successful participant in athletics, it is extremely important the student understands the conditions of participation before making the decision to enter the program.

ATHLETIC CODE OF CONDUCT

Violation of the *Athletic Code of Conduct* will be considered on an individual basis.... You will be treated fairly....You are an athlete year round. ... Comply with school policy....Conduct yourself as a lady/gentleman at all times....Always tell the truth....Do not steal.... Do not make excuses....Do your best in the classroom...Respect your teammates.

Do not participate in other non-school related sports while your sport is in season. Volleyball players that are in-season may not play club or LYSA volleyball, but may play club or LYSA Softball. ... Do not use tobacco, alcohol, drugs or any mood-altering chemical.. If you have a concern, talk to your coach in private.

DRESS AND GROOMING (ALL GRADE LEVELS)

In preparation for life after secondary education, students should learn that the context of the situation may dictate the appropriateness of dress and personal appearance. School is a business environment designed to prepare students to excel in the world of work and future educational institutions. Accordingly, the standard of dress and grooming required is set to that purpose. Requiring students to follow these dress and grooming standards contributes toward their preparation for future endeavors.

General Statement of Board Policy (See Policy FNCA)

Any dress or grooming that interferes with or disrupts the school environment or may create a health hazard to themselves or to others, may be excluded from school. The campus principal is empowered to make such judgments.

Students shall be clean, well groomed, and neatly dressed.

Apparel designed for sleepwear will not be permitted (e.g. pajama pants, house shoes, etc.) Bizarre dress or clothing that makes even casual reference to drugs or drug paraphernalia, alcohol, tobacco, electronic cigarettes, or other electronic vaporizing devices, gangs, weapons, violence, sexual innuendoes, satanic or hostile implications, profanity, organizations or groups (whether real or fictitious) which promote any of the above, or other statement, reference, or depiction deemed inappropriate by the administration or misrepresenting police or other lawful organizations shall not be worn.

Any dress determined by the principal to be related to gangs will not be permitted on school property, including but not limited to colors, emblems, or style of clothing. Sleeves may not be worn so as to cover the student's hands.

<u>Pants</u>: Oversized pants are not allowed. pants must fit at the waist and in the seat. Shoes must be visible from all lines of sight. Pants must be hemmed at the cuff. Unraveled hems/cuffs are not allowed. Holes in pants will not be permitted. Spandex/biker pants are not permitted, unless shorts meeting dress code are worn over them. Undergarments must not be visible.

Shirts: No shirts/tops should be oversized. Shirts longer than the bottom seam of the back pants pocket must be tucked in. Unbuttoned over shirts will be permitted if not oversized and the undershirt tucked in. Shirt length must cover midriff when arms are raised above the head. Halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti-strap type shirts or blouses, shirts with sleeves cut off, torn or "holey" apparel, fishnet, sheer or other see-through type shirts, or other dress deemed inappropriate by school officials shall not be worn. Garment must cover the entire back, cleavage, chest and stomach. Undergarments must not be visible.

<u>Dresses/Shorts</u>: Halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti-strap type dresses, dresses with sleeves cut off, torn or "holey" apparel, fishnet, sheer or other see-through type dresses, or other dress deemed inappropriate by school officials shall not be worn. Undergarments must not be visible, Garment must cover the entire back, cleavage and chest. Garments such as skirts, dresses, and shorts, must be <u>longer</u> than the tips of the fingers when the student's arms, hands, and fingers are extended down the student's leg. Spandex/biker shorts are not permitted, unless shorts meeting above length requirements are worn over them. The standard enforcement will be that the garment is obviously in compliance with the stated standard while the student is participating in normal school activities. Shorts and dresses must be hemmed; no cut-offs will be allowed. Skirts featuring high slashes are not appropriate for school. It is recommended that elementary girls wearing dresses should wear shorts under them.

Accessories: Hats, caps, visors, bandannas, or headgear of any kind shall not be worn, and will not be allowed on campus, including school buses. Sunglasses or any other distracting accessory shall not be worn in the school building. No chains, including billfold chains, will be allowed. Rolling backpacks are not permitted at the schools.

<u>Footwear</u>: Proper footwear should be worn at all times. Elementary school students should not *wear* heelys, flip-flops or similar footwear,

<u>Coats</u>: Lightweight jackets or sweaters will be allowed in the building. Winter coats should be placed into the student's locker or assigned area upon arrival at school.

Body Piercing: Piercing is allowed in the ears only. Boys may wear one small loop earring or stud in each ear. The loop may not be larger than the end of a person's little finger tip. Gauges are not permissible. Boys may not wear any type of dangling earring. Body piercing of the nose, eyebrow, tongue, or any other visible area other than the ear will not be allowed.

Tattoos: No visible tattoos of any kind will be permitted. Existing visible tattoos shall be covered at all times during school or at any school sponsored activity.

<u>Hair:</u> Hair should be kept neat, clean, and out of eyes. Only natural hair colors will be permitted. Styles which call undue attention to the wearer (such as Mohawks, etchings, etc.), or which are disruptive will not be permitted. Facial hair must be neat and closely trimmed.

Identification Cards: Picture IDs are required to be worn at all times during school hours by all high school students while on campus. ID cards must be visible and displayed above the waist and on the front side of the body. ID cards must be the cards supplied to the student by the school.

<u>Security Monitors</u>: If students should be required to wear security monitors, such devices must be covered by clothing/apparel at all times. Scope of Dress and Grooming Code

This Code is applicable to students during any school activity on or off school property, before, during, and after normal school hours, including nights and weekend activities. The principal shall have the authority to designate a modified Code for certain activities, such as but not limited to the Senior Prom, Graduation, school dances, special assemblies, banquets, etc. Students attending such activities shall be expected to comply with the Code established by the principal.

Nothing in the dress code shall interfere with the normal operation of such classes as physical education or other such activities.
