## **Player-Coach-Parents-Relations**

We at Castleberry believe in a team concept. We all have roles to play in the development of all of our athletes. As coaches, we are fortunate to be a part of your son's life. Our role as a coach is to provide an opportunity for the player to fully develop the skills needed to become the best he can possibly become, while fulfilling the important task of fitting into a team concept.

### **Coach to Player Communication when parent conflict occurs:**

1. Communicate openly with players about potential problems. Explain to your son that playing time and strategy will not be discussed with your parents.
2. If parents call or e-mail a football coach, we will inform your son of the contact from their parent.
3. The call or e-mail will be discussed with the player. Parent comments will be shared with the player.

### **Parent to Coach Communication:**

If, as a parent, you have a concern about your son's physical and/or mental safety, take the following steps:

1. E-mail your son's position coach and copy Coach Silva [silvaj@castleberryisd.net](mailto:silvaj@castleberryisd.net)
2. Upon receiving the e-mail, I will reply back that your son will be notified of your concern. At this time, a meeting will be set up with the position coach, your son and myself is necessary.
3. If you do not receive an e-mail reply, you may call Coach Silva at 940-595-3719.
4. If you feel that the issue has not been resolved after the individual meeting with only your son, then contact me via e-mail and I will set up a meeting with the above parties and the concerned parent. Remember that only safety issues will be discussed. Playing time, team strategy, playing time of other players, etc. will not be involved.
5. If there is still a conflict after the above meeting, contact me and I will set up a meeting with the above parties and Lenny Lasher, the district athletic director.

\*Remember the resolution of a conflict is in this order and the contact will be through Coach Silva.

As with all programs at CISD, the coaching staff will always communicate with you and your child on the ways of improving their fundamentals and skills, but the following WILL NOT be discussed:

1. Playing Time
2. Play Selection
3. Personnel

## **24 Hour Rule**

Please do not approach our coaches on the field or by dressing rooms after a game. Give 24 hours before you contact a coach about your concern. If you still feel the need to contact a coach after 24 hours, please go through the below steps in order to set up a meeting:

1. Email the position coach or head coach of the team
2. Copy Coach Silva on the mail
  - a. Include your name
  - b. Include your child's name
  - c. Include a short description of the concern
  - d. Include a contact number

I Will get back to YOU with either an answer or option of times for YOU to meet with the desired party. Often, if concern arises on a Thursday night, it could be Monday before I get back to you because of the hectic day a Friday can be, but I will contact you on Monday.

  - a. MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL FOR 5 OF THE 8 PERIODS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN PRACTICE OR COMPETE AT A GAME
3. Death in Family: Notification to Coach Silva
4. Family Emergency: Notification to Coach Silva
5. Tutorials / STAAR Related / School Related: Notification to Coach Silva

### **Unexcused:**

1. Absences due to vacation of any kind
2. Any of the Excused absences that require notification to a coach and notification does not occur
3. Absent from Practice

### **Any Excused Absence:**

1. Athlete will do the same conditioning that the team performed the day the athlete missed.
2. Athlete must complete 200 yards of tire flips
3. Athlete will not start the game that week.

### **Any Unexcused Absence:**

1. Athlete will do the same conditioning that the team performed the day the athlete missed.
2. Athlete must complete 400 yards of tire flips
3. Athlete will not start the game that week.

Any unexcused absence also gives the coach the authority to not allow your student / athlete to play that week. Excessive unexcused absences will result in complete removal from the program.

### STANDARD REQUIREMENTS FOR LETTER JACKET RECIPIENTS (GRADES 9 - 12)

When determining letter jacket recipients, sponsors will observe the following standard requirements:

1. The student and parent/ guardian must sign the organization's extracurricular participation agreement.
2. The student must be considered a participant from the first until the final date of the season.
3. The student must remain academically eligible from the first until the final date of the season.
4. The student must demonstrate an attitude of commitment while exemplifying the philosophy of the organization.
5. The student must be recommended by the sponsor of the organization and approved by the principal and appropriate director.
6. Student letter jackets will be provided by the district for approved organizations. Students will receive only one jacket with one varsity letter during their high school career. An additional symbolic award will be presented to a student who earns an additional letter(s) by the corresponding organization. Additional patches will be the financial responsibility of the student.

In addition to the above standard requirements, the sponsor may request that additional requirements be identified for his/her program.

Football	Aug.-Oct.	Play in a minimum of eight (8) quarters at the varsity level.
Cross Country	Aug.-Oct.	Participate in three (3) varsity meets and the District Cross Country Meet.
Volleyball	Aug.-Oct.	Participate in ten (10) games at the varsity level.
Basketball	Nov.-Feb.	Participate in ten (10) games at the varsity level.
Soccer	Nov.-Mar.	Participate in seven (7) games at the varsity level.
Track	Feb.-May	Earn 10 points in the season or 1 point at the District Track Meet.
Baseball	Feb.-May	Compete in (innings) as total number of games. Example 28 games = 28 innings
Softball	Feb.-May	Compete in (innings) as total number of games. Example 28 games = 28 innings.
Tennis	Feb.-Apr.	Participate in two (2) varsity meets and the District Tennis Meet.

## DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS GRADES 9-12

A participant school or member school district may give an award not to exceed \$70 in value to a student during that student's high school enrollment at the same school for participation in U.I.L. interschool competition. Each year a participant school or member school district may present additional awards, not to exceed \$20 each, for participation in each additional interschool organization.

The major award (\$70) presented to a student participating in the organization in grades 9-12 is a jacket with an attached 5" letter. This award will be presented to the student in the sport in which he/ she first earns a letter. An additional symbolic award will be presented to a student who earns an additional letter/ s. The additional award shall not be given to a student for an activity during the same school year that a major award is earned, if the total award exceeds \$70.

## GRADES 7-8

A participant school may not give and a student may not accept awards for participation in interschool competition in excess of \$8 per year (total for all U.I.L. activities). A student may accept a symbolic award in recognition of his/ her achievement in an interschool contest if it is given by the organization conducting the contest (all tournament awards, ribbons, plaques, and medals).

Individual certificates of achievement will be presented to students in grades 7 and 8 for each sport in which the student participates and fulfills the Standard Requirements for Award Recipients as identified in this section.
